

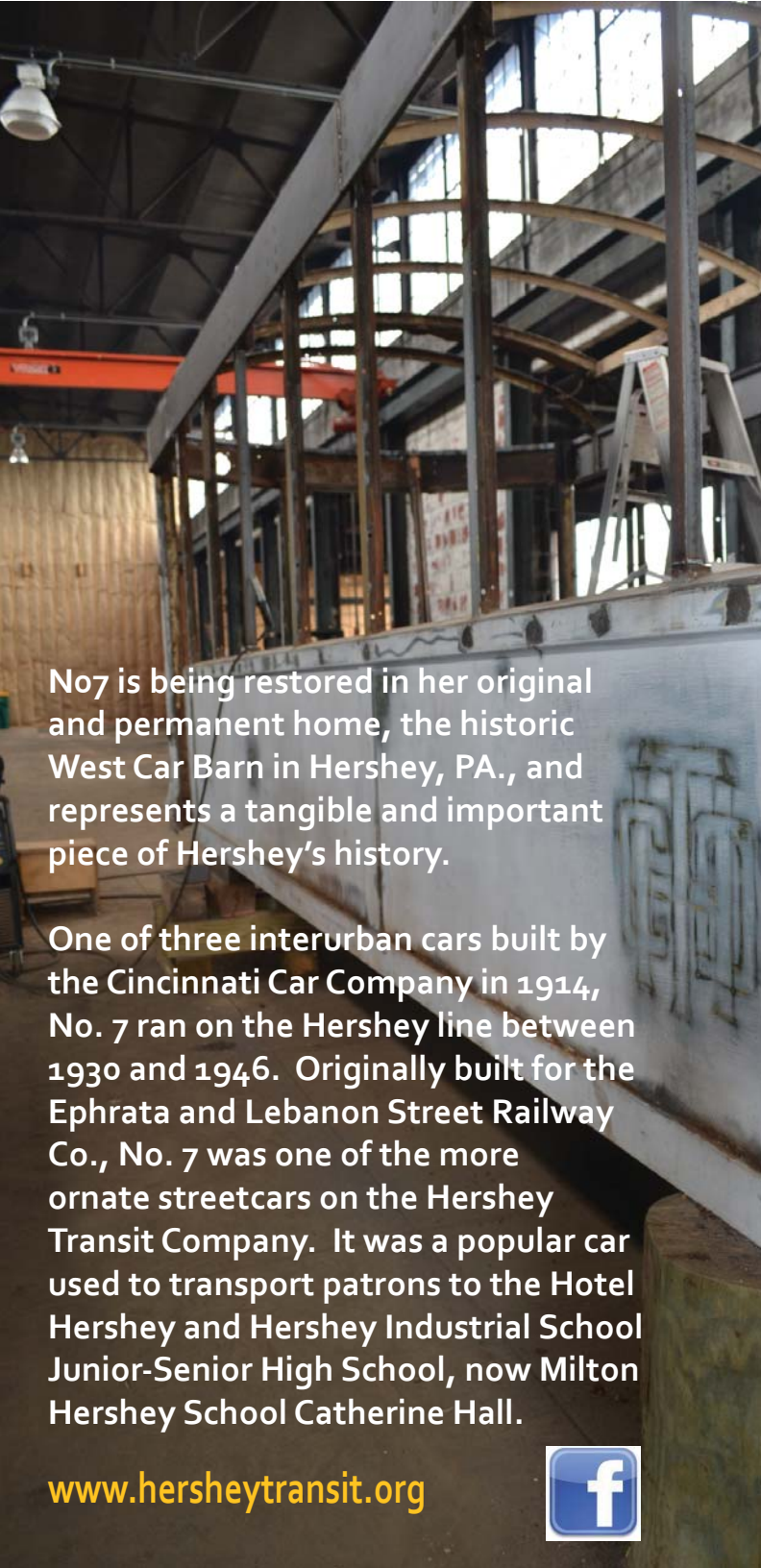
No7 Carbody Steel Restoration Campaign

No7 is being restored in her original and permanent home, the historic West Car Barn in Hershey, PA., and represents a tangible and important piece of Hershey's history.

One of three interurban cars built by the Cincinnati Car Company in 1914, No. 7 ran on the Hershey line between 1930 and 1946. Originally built for the Ephrata and Lebanon Street Railway Co., No. 7 was one of the more ornate streetcars on the Hershey Transit Company. It was a popular car used to transport patrons to the Hotel Hershey and Hershey Industrial School Junior-Senior High School, now Milton Hershey School Catherine Hall.

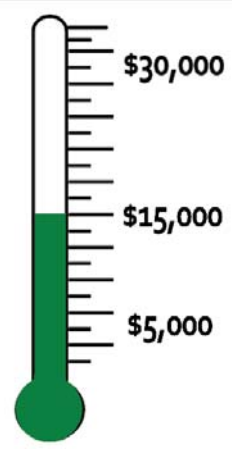
